RESOLUTION NO. 4080 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT THE AMENDED ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE CDBG-CARES ACT AND THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD, CONNECTICUT

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the City of Stamford was awarded an FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$574,820.00) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-Cares Act) Program for Federal Fiscal Year 2020 the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2020, the Board of Representatives approved the PY2020 CDBG-CV Annual Action Plan (Including Funding Recommendations); and

WHEREAS, these funds are subject to filing an amended Annual Action Plan and completion of all citizen participation requirements:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Mayor is hereby authorized to file an amended Annual Action Plan, incorporating the CDBG-Cares Act budget during the Year 46 regular CDBG process. The Mayor is further authorized to execute all related forms for the Community Development Program, including all understandings and assurances/certifications contained therein; and the Mayor is directed and authorized to act in connection with the Consolidated Plan and related forms and execute all related contracts for the receipt of CDBG-Cares Act funding and to provide such additional information as may be required including reprogramming of existing Community Development funds and program income; and further;

The above Resolution shall be effective upon enactment.

This resolution was approved by unanimous voice vote at a Special Meeting of the 30th Board of Representatives held on Monday, December 28, 2020.
