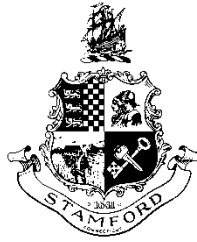

Mr. Handler called the hearing to order at 11:07 a.m. Ms. Kaufman submitted a copy of the legal notice of the hearing and evidence of individual property owner notification.

Mr. Minor made a brief presentation of the project.

One member of the public, Mr. de la Cruz, expressed concerns about potential adverse traffic implications.

For the record, Ms. Kaufman stated that the road to be discontinued includes Waterside Place and a stretch of road called the Unnamed Highway, a total of approximately 18,280 square feet (.42 acres). The discontinuance would allow for the next step, the property swap.

The Director of Administration indicated that he would make no changes to the preliminary report issued by his office in connection with this discontinuance.

There being no other speakers, Mr. Handler adjourned the hearing at 11:30 a.m.
