## **RESOLUTION NO. 4054 RECOGNIZING THE INTERSECTION OF STILLWATER AVENUE AT SMITH STREET WITH THE HONORARY NAME OF "ANTHONY PELLICCI CORNER"**

**WHEREAS**, Section 21-4 of the Code of Ordinances permits the placing of commemorative signs on city streets or segments thereof in recognition of individuals who have contributed significant accomplishments to the City of Stamford or a community within the city and provides that where possible, the location of any such commemorative signs shall be reasonably related to the individual and the accomplishments being recognized; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 21-5 of the Code of Ordinances provides that such a commemorative sign may only be placed on a city street or segment if a petition has been submitted to the City in favor of the proposed naming, containing the signatures of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the record owners of the properties on such city street or segment thereof; if there has been a specific finding by the Board of Representatives that such person has contributed significant accomplishments to the City of Stamford or a community within the city and if that person shall have been a resident of the City of Stamford for at least ten (10) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Representatives has received a petition signed by the property owners adjacent to the intersection of Stillwater Avenue at Smith Street, requesting that the Board of Representatives honor Anthony Pellicci by giving the intersection of Stillwater Avenue at Smith Street the honorary name of "Anthony Pellicci Corner" in recognition of Mr. Pellicci's contributions to the community and Boxer Square; and

**WHEREAS**, Anthony Pellicci was born in Stamford in 1937 and continued to run the restaurant on Stillwater Avenue on the West Side opened by his parents in 1947 from the 1960s until his passing


**WHEREAS**, Anthony Pellicci was active in the effort to revitalize the West Side and regularly worked to improve the neighborhood, including spearheading the creation of a community space at the newly renovated Boxer Square.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford that the Intersection of Stillwater Avenue at Smith Street shall be given the honorary name of "Anthony Pellicci Corner."


