**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION  
155-9(a) OF THE STAMFORD CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING  
EXTERIOR LIGHTING ENFORCEMENT**

This ordinance proposes a targeted amendment to Section 155-9(a) of the City of Stamford Code of Ordinances, which governs enforcement of exterior lighting standards under Chapter 155.

The change clarifies who may enforce the lighting regulations by expanding enforcement authority to include civil citation officers appointed by the Mayor, in addition to the Zoning Enforcement Officer, their designees, and the Chief Building Official or designees.

No other provisions of Section 155-9 are being amended. The update is intended to enhance flexibility and administrative efficiency in issuing citations for lighting violations.
