Chair DeLuca opened the public hearing. There being no members of the public present wishing to speak, the public hearing was closed. Committee members discussed the various proposed changes.

A motion to amend the ordinance to increase the violation for parking “Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic” (A.1(c)) from a Class II violation to a Class III violation was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 6-0-0. (Reps. DeLuca, Di Costanzo, Giordano, Kooris, Moore and Pratt in favor).

A motion to amend the ordinance to increase the violation for parking “Wrong way on street against the flow of traffic.” (A.1(f)) from a Class II violation to a Class III violation was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 6-0-0. (Reps. DeLuca, Di Costanzo, Giordano, Kooris, Moore and Pratt in favor).

A motion to approve the Ordinance, as amended, was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 7-0-0 (Reps. DeLuca, Di Costanzo, Giordano, Kooris, Moore and Pratt in favor).
