Mr. Toma explained that this an amendment to an existing ordinance. The revision makes clear that the fine for a violation can be as high as \$250.00. The enforcement officer is left the discretion to impose a fine up to that amount. This is needed because [§231-23](#) limits fines in this article to \$100, except as otherwise provided.

The amendment would permit a higher penalty and also makes clear that §231-15 can be enforced by the civil citation process. State statutes also cover this ground and these changes are consistent with State law but provide an additional avenue for enforcement. The State fine is \$500.00.

There being no quorum present, no action was taken by the Committee.
